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Circular No. \$\insigma' 2023 - cum-IMMM Amendment No. MM/108/2023, BL Amendment No. 01/148 and 02/119

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Sub: Intimating the reasons for rejection of the bidder before opening the Price bids.

While considering a representation, IEMs had opined that ONGC should follow similar methodology as being followed in GeM tenders regarding intimation of reasons for rejection to unsuccessful bidders and providing 48 hours window to bidder, whose offer has been rejected, to challenge their rejection.

Therefore, as advised by IEMs, in all non-GeM Tenders also, bidders whose bid have been rejected during techno-commercial evaluation, shall be informed about the reasons for rejection of their bid. Such bidders can review reason for rejection of their bid and raise a one-time representation to challenge rejection for any incorrect disqualification within 2 days of such intimation. Work centers will have to respond to all such representation before opening of price bids.

In view of above, relevant provisions of Integrated MM Manual stand modified as per Annexure-1 and Standard Tender/Contract Conditions for Procurement of Goods (ICB), Goods (NCB) and Services stand modified as per Annexure-2. Wherever applicable, suitable modifications should also be incorporated in tenders for Charter Hiring of Rigs and LSTK/Works tenders invited by concerned Work Centres.

Above guidelines should be meticulously followed by all concerned in all the future tenders including tenders where techno-commercial bids are yet to be opened.

In order to facilitate the bidders to know the details of other bidders short-listed for opening of price bids, besides mentioning the date, time and venue of the price bid opening, the names and particulars of all the bidders being invited to participate in the price bid opening should also be indicated in one common letter which should be addressed to all the bidders who have been short-listed for price bid opening. For this purpose, identified fax/ official e-mail of the firm indicated in the offer is to be used. The priced bids will be opened by Tender Opening Officers who are already detailed for opening of tenders as per provisions of para 12.24 of the Manual. For item/group-wise tenders, price bids should be sealed individually for items/groups and placed within the final price bid envelope submitted.
