**<u>Eligibility Criteria</u>:** M.Sc. (Chemistry)/ B.Tech. (Chemical Engineering) from a reputed Institute with min. 60% marks or equivalent grade. **OR** M.Tech. in Chemical Engineering (Duration of course would be reckoned as experience)

#### Job Description & Responsibilities:

- Assist, Co-ordinate, monitor project related activities and data management
- Interpretation of experimental data and preparation of project related documents and various miscellaneous activities related with various projects

### Place of Posting: Panvel

**Compensation:** Rs.42000/- per month which includes Fellowship Amount of Rs.32,000/and HRA Amount of Rs.10,000/-. This amount may be increased to Rs. 44,000/- per month after successful completion of one year and to Rs. 48,000/- per month after successful completion of two years. Further, one time annual incentive of two month's fellowship amount may also be given to outstanding performers. Candidates holding/obtaining Ph.D. Degrees while directly selected as Project Fellows are eligible for an additional incentive of Rs. 10,000/per month.

**Terms of Engagement**: The Project Fellow will be initially engaged for a period of one year. The tenure of engagement may be extended on need basis for further period, subject to satisfactory individual performance and requirement of the Project. The total duration of engagement as a Project Fellow can be up to a maximum of four years.

<u>Selection Process</u>: Applicants will be considered through a two tier selection procedure i.e. screening of Application Formats, followed by Interview of Short listed candidates.
