Sub: Removal of monetary limit for procurement of goods through Government e-Marketplace (GeM)

Reference is invited to circular Nos. 52/2018 dated 04.10.2018 and 56/2018 dated 27.10.2018 whereby detailed guidelines on procurement of goods valuing upto ₹ 5 lacs through GeM online portal have notified for compliance by all concerned.

EPC, in its meeting (27/2018) held on 29.11.2018, reviewed the said limit for procurement of goods through GeM and decided that henceforth items available on GeM portal shall be procured through GeM irrespective of the value of the case.

In accordance with the aforesaid decision of EPC, relevant provisions of IMMM pertaining to procurement through GeM stand modified as per enclosed Appendix-1.

Above guidelines should be meticulously followed by all concerned.
