Circular No. 24/2018-cum-Integrated MM Manual Amendment No. 35/2018 cum BL Amendment No. BL/01/107 and BL/02/83

No: MAT/PMC/13(200)/2018 Dated: 25.05.2018

Sub: Qualification of bidders for participation in Pre-bid conference

Reference is invited to para 12.17.2 & 12.17.3 of Integrated MM Manual, wherein the provisions to allow representatives of bidders in the pre bid conference, have been stipulated.

It has been observed that deletion of requirement for submission of tender fee for participation has provided opportunity to non-serious vendors to attend pre-bid conference and / or to raise irrelevant queries. In order to restrict such bidders from participating in pre-bid conference, EPC, in its meeting (11/2018) held on 10.05.2018, desired that the bidders who are in the business of providing similar Services/Goods as per tender requirement should only be allowed to participate in Pre-Bid conference. EPC also directed to include in tender conditions that the bidders who have submitted queries within prescribed date and have agreed to depute their employees (preferably) who are competent to present their queries in the Pre-Bid Conference, shall only be allowed to attend pre-bid conference.

EPC also directed that depending on the complexity of the case, the maximum number of persons that would be permitted per bidder for pre-bid conference should also be decided by the work centre at the time of taking a call on holding of pre-bid conference against the tender and the limit so fixed for participation in the pre-bid conference should be indicated upfront in the bidding documents.

EPC also directed that it needs to be categorically and explicitly mentioned in the tender document that pre-bid queries shall be restricted to Technical Specifications, Scope of Work, Technical BEC, Special Conditions of Contract and mobilization/ delivery/ completion period only and that no queries whatsoever shall be entertained on provisions of GCC and other standard provisions/ proforma/ format of the tender document.

In accordance with the above decisions of EPC, relevant provisions of Integrated MM Manual, Standard Tender Conditions for Service Contracts and Standard Booklets MM01 & MM02 stand modified as per Appendix-1, Appendix-2 and Appendix-3 respectively and format for undertaking incorporated as per Appendix-4. Similar modifications should also be carried out in other types of Tender documents.

Above guidelines should be meticulously followed by all concerned.

6.	12.17.5	MM department/Tender Processing Group in association with the concerned technical department will prepare minutes of the prebid conference and obtain approval of the officer who chaired the pre-bid conference. Thereafter, in case no modifications are required in the BEC/specifications/scope of work/tender conditions, the bidder would be asked to submit their bids on due date and time. However, if, as a sequel to the pre-bid conference, modifications are required in the BEC and other tender conditions (excluding commercial conditions standardised by PMC), TC shall submit its recommendations for approval of the competent purchase authority (CPA) by providing detailed justification for agreeing to such modification(s). In this regard, Director concerned shall have full powers including in EPC level cases, provided, such changes are not in conflict with the existing policy/ procedure/ PMC instructions, However, in case of conflict requiring changes to existing policy/procedure/PMC instructions in all cases will require EPC approval.
