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Clarifications on circular Nos. 10/2017 and 11/2017 both dated 01.03.2017

Sub: Clarifications on circular Nos. 10/2017 and 11/2017 dated 01.03.2017.

In connection with the subject cited circulars pertaining to experience and financial criteria in respect of Service Contracts, the clarifications by some of the work centers are replied hereunder:

SI NO.	Clarifications sought by work centers on Experience Criteria	PMC Response
Pertaining to Circular No. 10/2017		
1	As per note No. vii, financial criteria parameters should be in proportion to the percentage of work to be performed by Leader/members of consortium, subject to minimum of 50% / 20% respectively (of their annualized bid value). In case annualized bid value of leader / members is more than 50% / 20% whether requirement under financial parameters shall be ascertained on percentage of work to be performed by them or minimum 50% / 20% annualized bid value of Leader / other members.	It is clarified that "Percentage of Turnover, Net-worth and working capital criteria (as specified above) of the leader and members of consortium shall be calculated considering either (i) percentage of work to be performed by them OR (ii) minimum 50% annualized bid value for the leader and 20% annualized bid value for each member, whichever of (i) and (ii) is higher."
Pertaining to Circular No. 11/2017		
1	Whether modified provisions under clause B.1-2.4 shall also be applicable for NCB tenders.	The modified provisions under clause B-1-2.4 shall be applicable for both type of tenders i.e. ICB/NCB.
2	Similar type of provisions pertaining to Consortium bids are appearing under clause 1.3 and 7.14 of ITB. Bringing consortium provisions under single clause will help in better understanding.	In line with the guidelines issued vide circular No. 11/2017 dated 1.3.2017, some of provisions appearing under clause 1.3 of ITB of standard tender conditions for service contracts (available at MM-website) have also been relocated under para 7.14, substituting clause 7.14 (c) to (m). These changes have been incorporated in the standard documents for Service Contracts.

Above clarification should be meticulously followed by all concerned.
