VINESH PHOGAT DISQUALIFIED OVER WEIGHT

100 grams weigh down over a billion hearts

IN A HEARTBREAKING twist of fate, wrestler Vinesh Phogat was disqualified from the 50-kg gold medal bout at the Paris Olympics after failing the weigh-in because she was 100 grams overweight.

In a statement in Lok Sabha, Sports Minister Mansukh Mandaviya said the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) has lodged a strong protest with the United World Wrestling (UWW), the sport's governing body.

Phogat was to face USA's Sarah Hilderbrandt in the final on Wednesday, but will now return empty-handed despite becoming the first Indian woman wrestler to have reached an Olympic final on Tuesday night.

Dr Dinshaw Pardiwala, Chief Medical Officer of the Indian contingent in Paris, confirmed that Phogat was 100 grams above the permissible weight, and said she and the accompanying medical team raced against time, all night, to help her make the cut.

"cutting her hair" and "shortening her clothes".

But, "despite all efforts", she was still 100 grams overweight at the time of weigh-in, he said. "Vinesh was found to be 100 grams over her 50-kg weight category, and hence, she was disqualified. All possible drastic measures, including cutting off her hair, were used. However, she was not below her allowed weight of 50kg," Dr Pardiwala said in a statement.

Sources said the Indian delegation pleaded for some more time to give her a chance to shed the last 100 grams, but to no avail. Pardiwala said there are several factors involved in losing weight before any competition and the process has its after-effects as well. Saying that "small amounts of water had to be given to prevent dehydration", Pardiwala said Phogat's post-participation weight was found to have increased. "The coach initiated the normal process of weight cut that he has always employed with Vinesh and felt confident that it would be achieved," he said.

"Wrestlers usually partici-

pate in a weight category less than their natural weight. It gives them an advantage since they are fighting with less stronger opponents... The process of weight cut involves a calculated restriction of food and water along with sweating from exercises and sauna till the morning weigh-in," he explained.

"This weight cut causes weakness and energy depletion, which is counter-productive to participation, and hence, for energy restoration, limited water and high energy foods are given after weigh-in," he said. He said that Phogat's nutritionist had calculated this intake to add about 1.5 kg. "Sometimes, there is also a rebound weight gain following competition," he said.

After her disqualification, Phogat was taken to the Games Village polyclinic due to dehydration, and she is currently stable and her parameters are normal, he said.

IOA president PT Usha said she was "shocked and disappointed" and the IOA was following the matter "in the strongest possible manner".

WRESTLER VINESH PHOGAT will always be a champion, said politicians across party lines as they came out in support of the grappler after her disqualification from the Paris Olympics, with the government asking the Indian Olympic Association to take "appropriate action" in the matter.

In a shocking reversal of fortunes, Phogat was disqualified from the Olympics after being found overweight by 100 gram ahead of her women's 50 kg final, leaving her medal-less within hours of coming close to an unparalleled gold.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi and President Droupadi Murmu described the setback as painful but said Phogat is a champion among champions for the more than 1.4 billion people of India and the nation's pride.

In a statement in the Lok Sabha, Union Sports Minister Mansukh Mandaviya said the Indian Olympic Association lodged a strong protest with the United World Wrestling (UWW) over Phogat's disqualification and Prime Minister Modi has asked IOA chief PT Usha to take "appropriate action".

Leaders of several parties, including the Congress, demanded accountability be fixed and the decision leading to her disqualification be reviewed.

On X, Modi said, "Vinesh, you are a champion among champions! You are India's pride and an inspiration for each and every Indian."

"Today's setback hurts. I wish words could express the sense of despair that I am experiencing. At the same time, I know that you epitomise resilience. It has always been your nature to take challenges head on," he said.
